

## YMCA Camp Bernie Overnight Camp Packing List

Please pack according to the number of days your child will be here. Laundry services will be available on weekends for an additional charge. This can be added on your camper's online account.

Every item your child brings to YMCA Camp Bernie should be labeled with your child's first and last name. This helps camp manage lost and found, and campers are more likely to go home with everything they brought. Please pack your child's clothes in a suitcase or duffle bag. Footlockers & trunks consume too much space in the cabins.

- Long sleeve shirts/sweatshirts
- Small back pack
- Socks
- Underpants
- Swim suits
- Poncho /waterproof jacket
- Sunglasses
- Bug spray
- Fitted sheet with blanket or sleeping bag for bunk
- Pillow with pillowcase
- Comb and/or brush
- Soap and Shampoo
- Two bath towels or two beach towels
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Pens, stationary, stamps
- Rubber boots/hiking/work boots optional

- Long pants
- Shorts
- T-shirts
- Pajamas
- Shoes with a closed toe
- Water bottle (cups not provided)
- Hat
- Sunscreen
- Sleeping bag
- Toothbrush with holder
- Toothpaste
- Facemasks (just in case)
- Flip flops (worn in cabins & pool)
- Laundry bag (mesh or fabric)
- Disposable Camera (optional)

**Medication** – please pack all medications needed for the session duration. We recommend that all campers continue their regular medication schedule at camp that they would normally follow at home. Medicine must be in its original container with the proper prescription label affixed. Please keep medication handy for check-in.

Campers participating in Dirtbikes will need long pants, long-sleeved shirts, and boots with ankle support.
